Dear parent,

Was your child **born in 2020**?

Do you want your child to **change schools**?

How can you enrol your child in a school of your preference?

- **Was your child born in 2020 and does his/her sibling go to that school or do you work at that school?**
 - You can enrol your child in that school between 17 and 28 January 2022

- **In all other cases:**
 - Apply on <https://meldjeaanbasis.gent.be> between 16 February 2022 (12 noon) and 16 March 2022 (12 noon)
 - You will receive an e-mail or letter with the result on 28 March 2022.
 - Enrol your child in the school between 29 March and 4 May 2022
 - If all available places have already been taken, you can visit another school with vacant places from 6 May 2022 (9 A.M.) onwards.

Why do you apply for schools in Ghent?

By applying online, every child gets an equal opportunity to enrol in a school of preference. We try to form a balanced mix of advantaged and disadvantaged children in schools in the same neighbourhood. When assigning a school to your child, account will be taken of your school of preference as much as possible.

Other benefits of applying online

1. You will get **priority** over parents who don't apply online.
2. You can nominate multiple schools in order of preference.
3. Your child will be ranked in their school of preference, based on your **home to school or work to school distance**.
4. Your chances of getting a place at a school of your preference will increase.

WHICH CHILDREN?

- All children born in 2020, even if they cannot start school until 1 September 2023.
- Children who want to change schools.
- Was your child born in 2020 and does his/her sibling go to that school or do you work at that school? Then enrol your child in that school during the period of 17 to 28 January 2022. The enrolment is then complete.

WHICH SCHOOLS?

All mainstream education schools in Ghent and Merelbeke.

WHY?

To have a chance of getting a place at the school of your preference.

TO SPECIAL NEEDS EDUCATION

Beside mainstream education there is also special needs education at nursery and primary school levels.

How to enrol in a special needs school? Go to <https://gent-bao.lokaaloverlegplatform.be>.

In order to enrol your child in a school for special needs education you will need a referral. The CLB's (Pupil Guidance Centres) will help you with this matter.

Special needs education is aimed at children who require specific support due to a mental or physical disability or learning or behavioural problems. We distinguish between different types of special needs education:

- **Basic type (*type basic offer*):** for children with various severe learning disabilities.
- **Type 2:** for children with a mental disability.
- **Type 3:** for children with emotional or behavioural problems.
- **Type 4:** for children with a physical disability.
- **Type 5:** for children who are staying in a hospital, a residential institution or a sanatorium.
- **Type 6:** for children with a visual impairment.
- **Type 7:** for children with a hearing impairment or a speech or language impediment.
- **Type 9:** for abled children with an autism spectrum disorder.

3 When can my toddler start school?

Children already aged 3 can start school on any school day.

4 What should I bring along when I go to enrol my child?

The ISI card, Kids ID or sticker of your health insurance fund.

The school needs an official document with the correct spelling of your child's name and national identification number (*rijksregisternummer*).

5 What happens during my child's enrolment?

1. The school verifies the information about your child.
2. You have to agree with the school rules and educational vision.
3. You have to sign the enrolment record.
4. You receive a proof of enrolment.

6 What happens if a school refuses my child?

1. Your child's name will appear in the enrolment record.
2. You will receive a refusal document and your child gets a rank number.
3. For children born in 2020, the school has to respect this rank number until 30 June 2023. For children born before 2020, the school has to respect this rank number until 7 October 2022.
4. The waiting lists are valid for one school year. You can register again every year.

7 Why do I need to apply for my child?

Schools see their available places filled very quickly. By using an application system, each child gets an equal chance to enrol in a school of its choice as close as possible to where you live, so your child(ren) can get to school on foot.

8 Can I apply to more than one school?

Yes. There is no limit. You should apply to at least 5 schools to increase your chances of finding a free place. The more schools you apply with, the greater the chances of finding a school of your preference. Also choose schools with enough available places.

9. Which school do I put as my number 1?

Put the school of your preference at the top of your list, even if there appear to be few or no places available. Even if there's no room available for your child now, a space may free up. You can then still enrol your child. Even if you have already enrolled your child in another school.

After school 1, put the school that's your second preference, etc.

10 Do people who apply before I do have more chance of getting a place?

No. It does not matter when exactly you submit your application, as long as you do so between 16 February and 16 March 2022 (12 noon).

When demand exceeds supply, we only look at the parents' preference, the distances to the school and the social mix.

11 When do I create a login?

During the application period: 16 February– 19 March 2022 (until 12 noon).

12 How do I know if there is a place available for my child?

When applying you can check the availability of places in every school during the application period. Make sure that you also choose schools with enough available places left for your child's age group.

13 What should I do if I want to make additional changes during the application period (e.g. adding a new school)?

You can view or change your information by logging in with your user name and password.

14 I don't have a computer. What can I do?

Please contact one of the organisations (see page 8) or one of the schools. They will help you out.

15 How do we rank the children? In which school can your child enrol ?

First, we create two groups according to the social mix indicators (see question 16). We then arrange each child twice. We order the children according to the distance 'child's domicile from school'. We then order the same children again according to the shortest of the three distances (see question 19). The children who live closest to the school and/or whose parents work closest to the school are given the free spaces.

We arrange your child for all the schools you have selected. You can enrol your child in the school that is ranked highest on your list of preferred schools and has a free place for your child.

16 What does social mix mean?

We aim to evenly distribute children from advantaged and disadvantaged families within the schools in the same neighbourhood. As a consequence, schools in most areas will reflect the social mix of inhabitants of the area (in the long term). To determine the groups, we look at the mother's level of education and whether the family receives school allowances (see question 26).

17 Indicator pupil or non-indicator pupil?

Indicator pupil = the family receives school allowances from the growth package and/or the mother does not have a secondary education degree

Non-indicator pupil = the family does not receive a school allowance and the mother has at least a secondary education degree.

18 How many free places are assigned to children living close to the school?

In each school, at least 75% of available places are assigned to children living closest to the school.

19 How many places are assigned to children whose parents work close to the school?

In each school no more than 25% of the available places are assigned to children living closest to school. For each child, we compare the distance "child's domicile to school" with the distance "parent's place of work to school". We take the shortest distance to arrange the children.

20 Which addresses can I mention?

The child's domicile and a maximum of two work addresses. You can determine which work addresses you mention. The computer will calculate the shortest distance. If you take the train to work, you cannot enter the train station address.

If you do not provide a work address, we will only use the "child's domicile from school" to calculate the "shortest distance".

21 We will be moving soon. I'm changing jobs. Which address should I mention?

Please submit your new address during the application. However, you will be asked to present proof of your new address when enrolling your child. You will have to live at the new address or work at the new address in the next school year.

22 If my child attends childcare in a certain school, do I get priority?

No

23 Is it possible my child gets a school that I did not choose?

No. We will only list your child in the schools you have indicated. It is possible that there is no space in for your child in the schools you chose. In that case, your child is put on the waiting list. You can then wait until a place becomes available in those schools. Or you can enrol your child in a school that still has free spaces. That will be possible as from 6 May 2022, 9 A.M..

24 What happens if I don't apply for my child?

In that case you can start looking for an available place from 6 May 2022 (9 A.M.) onwards, but a lot of schools will already be full. That is why we strongly recommend you to apply!

25 Once I have applied for my child, does that mean my child is enrolled?

No. You still have to enrol your child in the school it was given a place between 29 March and 4 May 2022.

26 Can I receive a Flemish school allowance?

The Flemish Community grants a school allowance to parents with low incomes. Education allowances are integrated in the child benefit system. You will receive the education allowance automatically via your child benefit fund.
